**IMPORTANT: INTERSTATE 10 THROUGH CENTRAL TUCSON IS UNDER MAJOR RECONSTRUCTION. THERE IS ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION IN AND AROUND THE DOWNTOWN. DO NOT RELY ON MAPQUEST OR GOOGLE MAPS TO GET YOU HERE. FOLLOW THE APPROPRIATE DIRECTIONS BELOW.**

**From Tucson International Airport:**

Take the one and only exit from the airport (Tucson Boulevard). Continue on Tucson beyond the signal at Valencia Road and proceed about three miles. After crossing the signal for Irvington Road, get in the right lane and prepare to turn right onto Kino Parkway. Continue on Kino Parkway for approximately 3 miles. As you cross the signal for 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, get in the left lane and prepare to turn left at the signal at the top of the overpass onto AZ-210 West. As you merge onto the expressway, gradually work your way over to the far left lane. The expressway will end in about one mile at Broadway. Turn left onto Broadway and cross through the underpass, remaining in the left lane. When you emerge from the underpass you will come to a "Y" intersection, bear to the left. This will place you on Congress Street. Continue on Congress Street beyond the light at Sixth Avenue, staying in the left lane. Turn left at the very next signal for Scott Avenue. Cross the signal at Broadway and proceed two blocks, passing Jackson Street and Ochoa Street. The next street on the right is Corral Street. Our home is on the corner of Scott and Corral. It is a white house with a copper patina (green) colored roof. There is a flagpole in the front yard.

**I-10 coming from the direction of Phoenix and San Diego:**

As you enter the outskirts of Tucson (around milepost 245), watch for construction signs for LOCAL traffic and/or traffic to DOWNTOWN. You will want to be in the far right lane and take **Exit 254 - Prince Road**. This will place you on the Eastbound I-10 Frontage Road. Continue on the Frontage Road for five miles, crossing signals at Prince, Miracle Mile, Grant, Speedway and Saint Mary's. After Saint Mary's Road, get in the far left lane and turn left at the next signal for Congress Street/Broadway (this street may be unsigned so look for the Carl's Jr. restaurant on the corner as an indication that you have reached Congress/Broadway). Cross under the freeway and continue forward into Downtown. Cross the signals at Granada, Church and Stone. Turn right at the very next signal for Scott Avenue. Proceed two blocks, passing Jackson Street and Ochoa Street. The next street on the right is Corral Street. Our home is on the corner of Scott and Corral. It is a white house with a copper patina (green) colored roof. There is a flagpole in the front yard.

NOTE: If you miss Exit 254, have no worries. You will be express-routed past Downtown. After you leave the construction zone (still on I-10 East) prepare to take **Exit 263-B – Kino Parkway North** and follow the first set of directions on the following page.

**I-10 coming from the direction of El Paso:**

As you enter the outskirts of Tucson (around milepost 270), ignore the construction detour signs and prepare to take **EXIT 263B – Kino Parkway North**. Continue on Kino Parkway for approximately 3 miles. As you cross the signal for 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, get in the left lane and prepare to turn left at the signal at the top of the overpass onto AZ-210 West. As you merge onto the expressway, gradually work your way over to the far left lane. The expressway will end in about one mile at Broadway. Turn left onto Broadway and cross through the underpass, remaining in the left lane. Turn left onto Broadway and cross through the underpass, remaining in the left lane. When you emerge from the underpass you will come to a “Y” intersection, bear to the left. This will place you on Congress Street. Continue on Congress Street beyond the light at Sixth Avenue, staying in the left lane. Turn left at the very next signal for Scott Avenue. Cross the signal at Broadway and proceed two blocks, passing Jackson Street and Ochoa Street. The next street on the right is Corral Street. Our home is on the corner of Scott and Corral. It is a white house with a copper patina (green) colored roof. There is a flagpole in the front yard.

**I-19 coming from the direction of the International Border:**

After passing the exit for Valencia Road and the Tucson Airport, watch for construction signs for LOCAL traffic and/or traffic to DOWNTOWN. As the freeway widens and you approach the flyover interchange with I-10, you will want to be in the CENTER lane, taking **Exit 102 – Silverlake / 29<sup>th</sup> Street / 22<sup>nd</sup> Street / Starr Pass**. This will place you on the I-10 Westbound Frontage Road. Continue about one mile, crossing the signals for 29<sup>th</sup> / Silverlake and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street / Starr Pass. You will cross one additional signal for an unnamed street. Get in the right lane and prepare to turn right at the very next signal for Congress Street. Continue forward into Downtown. Cross the signals at Granada, Church and Stone. Turn right at the very next signal for Scott Avenue. Proceed two blocks, passing Jackson Street and Ochoa Street. The next street on the right is Corral Street. Our home is on the corner of Scott and Corral. It is a white house with a copper patina (green) colored roof. There is a flagpole in the front yard.

**PARKING REMINDER:**

When you first arrive, please pull up to one of the metered spaces along the curb in front of our home. Do not feed the meter, but come to the door and ring the bell. Chuck and/or I will greet you and help you with your luggage. We will then have you move your car to our private parking—kindly provided to us by the Tucson Children’s Museum. It is the unpaved area on the opposite side of Scott Avenue from our front gate. Park perpendicular to the brick wall and allow space for additional guests to park along side of you. If you are staying over a weekend, you may also park on the street for free from 3:00 p.m. on Friday through 8:00 a.m. on Monday.
